Caring for the Sick \$20

Jean Aitcheson's Medical Mission Depot in Stratford, supporting interdenominational, faith-based volunteer missions that provide medical care and project work in impoverished Latin American countries.

Healing and Renewal \$20

Anglican Healing Fund response to the ongoing legacy of the residential schools: programs for healing, education, and recovery of Indigenous languages and cultures.

Improving Lives in Nicaragua \$30

Stratford-based COMMIT team, providing medical clinics, clean water and sanitation, eco-friendly stoves, sustainable vegetable gardens, and educational and social support in an impoverished region.

Saving Young Lives \$30

Anglican Indigenous Ministries program providing trained suicide prevention counsellors in First Nations, Métis and Inuit communities.

Clean Water to Save Lives \$50

An Aquabox will be sent on your behalf to purify water in an area struck by disaster – enough to supply a family of five with safe, clean drinking water for up to a year.

The full amount of your purchase goes to the organization or program chosen and is included in your tax-deductible givings to St. James.
