



Sermon Notes

"A Scandalous Perspective on Christmas"

We have so sanitized the Christmas story that we lose sight of some of the harsh realities of Immanuel – God with us. It is only as we see the story from a scandalous perspective that we get a fuller appreciation for the reality of the Christmas story. Matthew signals that some significant barriers will come down because of the Messiah's birth:

- A. The racial barrier between Jews and Gentiles.
- B. The gender barrier that developed after the Fall.
- C. The barrier between saint and sinner.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Why is it that we insist on sanitizing the Christmas story?
- 2. Are the barriers actually gone? How do we see evidence of these barriers today?
- 3. If you were God, would you have scripted the Christmas story this way?
