

Questions to Think About and Discuss:

1. What does it mean to belong to the family of God?

2. If anyone who does the will of God belongs to the family of God, what does it mean to do the will of God? (3 sermon points)

3. Jesus disobeyed and likely even disrespected His mother and brothers. Did Jesus sin by doing so? Why or why not? What was Jesus trying to prove by responding to His family the way He did?

4. The Bible talks about the importance of taking care of our earthly families first, but also talks about the priority of the family of God first in our lives. Which way do you lean, and how can we reconcile this Biblical tension?

5. What should be our greatest desire for our children or family members or friends? If our greatest desire for them is to become part of the family of God by repenting and believing in Jesus, how can we help them do so?

6. Think about your commitment to the family of God. What are some ways you can better keep the family of God as priority number one?

7. Is there anyone you know of in our church who could benefit from joining your family during your Christmas plans?
