FREE PRAYERS OF THANKS: Aloud or in silence, offer your gratitude to God.

PSALM

GOSPEL READING: Listen for the word or phrase that is calling to you this day. Holy Wisdom, Holy Word. **Thanks be to God!**

SILENCE AS WE REFLECT ON THE WORD: Sit silently with the word or phrase that is calling to you. Allow it to unfold in your imagination and tend to

the images, feelings and memories that are stirred in you. Then listen for the invitation to you in the midst of the circumstances of your life right now. How are you being invited to respond?

Bell is rung.

Invitation to share reflections.

INTERCESSIONS:

Holy Mystery who is wholly love, bless all those in need of your healing love as we name them now aloud or in silence...

You are invited to share your prayers of concern aloud or in silence...

THE PRAYER OF JESUS: (an adaptation by Parker Palmer)

Heavenly Mother, heavenly Father, Holy and blessed is your true name.

We pray for your reign of peace to come,

We pray that your good will be done,

Let heaven and earth become one.

Give us this day the bread we need,

Give it to those who have none.

Let forgiveness flow like a river through us,

From each one to each one to each one.

Lead us to holy innocence

Beyond the evil of our days,

Come swiftly Mother, Father, come!

For yours is the power and the glory and the mercy—

Forever your name is All in One.
