Welcome to 2023! As we are look forward to the new year, I first want to thank you for your faithfulness and service in 2022. God continues to bless and use this church as we live out our calling

as the body of Christ. Here are some highlights from the last year:

- We saw a significant increase in our in-person Sunday worship attendance as we work our way past the pandemic. We averaged 267 in January 2022 and ended averaging 366 in December. It has been so refreshing seeing more and more people face-to-face worshipping together.
- With more people showing up in person our on-line viewership has decreased but we still have anywhere from 50-100 people watching online. An unintended blessing from the pandemic is our streaming service which continues to provide virtual worship for those unable to attend.
- Our Barnabas Center ministry continues to expand as we serve our community in the name of Christ to fight food insecurity.
- We collected almost \$60,000 for Ukrainian relief that was sent to a Christian outreach organization in Ukraine to minister to those affected by the ravages of war.
- We collected a record \$167,804 for our Grace Offering enabling us to financially assist in outreach efforts here in Texoma and around the world.
