Begin with Prayer

• Whether you are alone or with a group, in a living room or around a table, take a few minutes to invite the Holy Spirit to be with you and guide your time.

Reflection Questions

- In chapter 1, the prophet Amos pronounces judgement on Israel and Judah AND the surrounding nations. The rest of the book lays out specific reasons for that judgement and in the end gives evidence that everyone answers to God. *How might this thought be an encouragement?*
- Everyone answers to God because everyone is accountable to God. This means that no
 matter how we live in this life, when it's over our actions and (as Amos points out)
 inactions will be examined by God. Is this thought encouraging or threatening to you?
 Why?
- Consider your perspective of Justice and Judgement. Are they influenced by scripture or influenced by the culture around you?

Notes

- In this series, we want to let the Lord recalibrate our attitudes and perspectives of justice and judgement. Is it one or the other or do these things work together? Lots of questions for sure but ultimately we want to let the Lord guide our theology of these things.
