Reflection Questions

 - o Can you identify similar "threads" in today's culture?
 - If so, what do you feel can be done to address these systemic issues?
- Do you feel it's fair to suggest that ignoring those in our community who struggle with systemic issues such as those mentioned in these chapters is, at its core, tantamount to ignoring people whom God loves deeply?
- Feeling bad about the plight of "the other" is not enough, neither should we assume we can solve each and every social problem but we CAN and should (as God's people) act with compassion, fight injustice and do our part to care for those in need.
 - What might the role of the church be in responding in a Godly way to the marginalization of our neighbors?
 - How might God be calling you personally to respond?
