

# Acts at a Glance: <u>Getting into Acts.</u>

- 1. Luke is the author of the book of Acts. It is the second of his two-volume set. His gospel account was volume one.
- 2. The <u>date</u> of writing is mostly likely the <u>80's or 90's AD</u>.
- 3. The <u>context is one of struggle</u>, the Israelites navigating the danger between the Roman empire and a diaspora life experience.
- 4. The *literary genre* is primarily narrative. There are scenes, a plot, characters, tension, and multiple locations, multiple varied strands woven together like a fabric or quilt.
- 5. The <u>pace changes frequently</u>, with rapid changes in location, the inclusion of speeches/sermons, or pausing for detailed descriptions while in other cases summarizing many events in a few sentences.

#### Homework (Challenge accepted):

Read through the book of Acts in one sitting. It will probably take you 2 or 3 hours - the length of a movie. You can do it! And you will be so inspired and surprised when you do.

- 1. As a story, consider
  - a. Who are the different 'characters' in the scene?
  - b. Where is it taking place?
  - c. What is the tension?
- 2. Themes
  - a. What words or phrases are repeated?
  - b. Which stories or events are retold or restated?
- 3. About the Lord
  - a. What do you learn about God in the different interactions? God's purpose?
  - b. How is God's purpose being accomplished?
