

God is good and we are so blessed. Praise God that we can know the love of Christ and be filled with all the fullness of God. So many here need the water of life that only Christ can give. Pray that we won't drain each other and that we would be wise and seek spiritual nourishment from God alone.

Please pray for our Tamasheq refugee friends who come from the neighbouring country. They are a stateless people. Their children are particularly vulnerable, as they also are not citizens anywhere. This means that they cannot even legally rent a house in this country because they don't have identification. These families need to leave the continent to have a future. They need a welcoming country that will give them citizenship so they can make a life for themselves. Please pray for one particular family of 10 who need either to be accepted by a country through the UN or that there would be a fellowship or group that would be willing to help them immigrate to a country that would eventually grant them citizenship. This family can do nothing here or in their home country because they are not even considered people. We also pray that they might find their citizenship in heaven. Please lift us up in prayer as we share the good news with them in their difficult situation.

We are also hoping to come to Canada in the summer. Please pray that a visa would be granted for the visit. It can be hard for people from here to have their applications accepted and we would love to see all of you.
