CONVERSATIONS

- How would a non-believer describe what the 'gospel' is?
- Read Romans 1:8. Where have you been surprised to see or learn that the gospel is taking root?
- What "good news" happening here at Ridge Church has caught your attention?
- Read Romans 1:14 15. The 'Greeks' were the sophisticated, educated ruling class and the 'barbarians' were considered the inferior, uneducated serving class.
 - Why was Paul's 'obligation' to proclaim the gospel to both so radical in that day?
 - What are the implications of this attitude for us as a church today?
- Read Romans 1:16. (cf. Hebrews 12:1 2)
 - Why was the gospel considered shameful in Paul's day?
 - What are some of the ways that the message of the gospel is considered 'shameful' in our day?



- Why should we not be ashamed of the gospel?
- Who do you know that you have seen the power of God work in their life? How did the gospel change their life?
- For the Apostle Paul 'salvation' is more than just a one time event (i.e. saved from the punishment of our sins). It is also a process – the slow, steady transformation of a person to be more like Jesus. How is this different from how many people think of salvation?
- Read Romans 1:17.
 - What is the righteousness of God and why is it important that we receive it?
