And then the next thing outta their mouth is, but I can't, well, that doesn't make sense because if God is calling us to do something, it doesn't matter what it is. We've gotta rule our thoughts because if we don't rule our thoughts, then negative thoughts are going to rule us. Now, let me ask you this question tonight, and this may seem a little funny to you, but it's something that we all do. What do you say when you talk to yourself? <Laugh>?

(00:19:32):

What do you say when you talk to yourself? You say, what did you say? I said, what'd you say when you talk to yourself? And the reason I say that is because all of us do that, myself included, I followed a lady around Publix the other day, and she was talking to all kinds of people, probably I, I don't know. But she was doing a lot of talking to herself. And what she was doing is she was reminding herself about all the things that she needed to pick up at Publix. We've probably done the same thing. I mean, how many times have we got out of the car and we, you know, we get ready to go in Publix and we always want to say that, you know, we're not getting older. And we always wanna say, well, I don't need a grocery list. I can remember all this stuff.

(00:20:19):

My wife better not laugh here, <laugh>, but I practice it. I'm sitting in my truck and I practice, okay, you gotta get milk, okay, gotta get milk, I gotta get eggs. And most importantly, I have to get Reese's cups and maybe a few other things, you know? So I practice that from my truck all the way to the store. Something magically happens a lot of times when I grab the cart and I walk right into Publix, and the first thing they have is all the buy one, get one free stuff, <laugh>. So I start looking at that, and my train of thought goes, now I'm supposed to get 10 things. Now I'm down to eight things that I can remember. And the two things I can't remember are probably the two things that Vicky really wants the most. So I'm already in trouble, but we all talk to ourselves.

(00:21:08):

I'm not, but I'm not talking about the normal stuff. Alright? I'm not talking about milk and eggs and Reese's cups. What I'm talking about is what we talk about is what's going on with ourself. It's the stuff that we say over and over again in our mind. If you're like a lot of people, and a lot of us are this way, we get stuck in a very, very negative loop. If we're not careful, we talk to ourselves. And what we continually say to ourselves is stuff that we shouldn't be saying to ourself because it's negative stuff. And if we're not careful, we get into a real negative loop and we talk and we think about things that the Lord doesn't want us to think about. We think about things that Satan wants to interject into our life. Let me give you a few examples of that.

(00:22:04):

We think about money, and we always say to ourself, you know what? I am always going to struggle with money. Now, what have we just said? We've just said that there's no hope. Even though I'm a Christian, there's no hope. I can't ever come out of my financial troubles. What are we replaying our mind? Every time we think about money, we're replaying negative. Nothing positive about it is it? Or if we say to ourselves, you know, I can't trust anybody, somebody has let us down, maybe even somebody in the church, and maybe that's kind of skewed us. And we, we start thinking about people in a negative way. And everybody we meet, we always will say, well, you know, I wonder what's beside? I wonder

what's behind their facade. I wonder what they're really about. You know about Carl, when it comes right down to it, I can't trust anybody.

(00:23:01):

Well, you know, that's not true. All right? Satan wants us to think it is, but we play it over and over in our minds. We can't trust anybody. Or we say to ourself, you know what? I'm an idiot. I'm an absolute idiot. You know, I can't do anything. That's right. Every time I try to do something, I mess it up. I'm stupid. Things aren't gonna ever work out. How many times have we said that? Don't look at me. So spiritual, we've all said it. I've said it. I mean, my goodness, when I try to nail a nail straight and I can't do it, I said to myself, I'm stupid. I can't nail it. And then Satan says, you're right, you are. Look how dumb you are. Do you know how many people can drive a nail straight? You may be able to preach, but you sure can't drive a nail straight.

You know how stupid that makes me feel? And the devil, what he does is he hears my words. He hears your words. And what he does is he makes that a negative loop. And before we know it, we feel kind of bad about it. Somebody said something to me the other day, my day was going along really good. Somebody said something to me the other day, somebody said it. And you know what, it got into my heart because Satan knows where to hit me. Satan knows where to hit you. And out of the blue, somebody said something and it hit me, and it didn't bounce off, it stayed in my heart. And then when it stayed my heart, it started staying in my head. And I went home and I told Vicky, I says, there's something that is upsetting me. And I shared it with her.

(00:24:47):

And she said, well, honey, you don't need to think about that. You know that that isn't right. You know, that isn't right. But yeah, I knew it wasn't right. But still Satan says that I need to think about it. I need to dwell back. Why is that? Maybe some of you are like me. I if I have a fault, and I have a lot of them, but one of my big faults is I'm a perfectionist. Any of you like that? I'm a perfectionist. And when I don't do things the way I feel like God wants me to do 'em, I beat myself up. Sometimes I shouldn't because I'm human. I understand that. But I want to excel so much at what God's called me to do. I want to do it in excellence because I, it's not a reflection on me as much as it is a reflection on him.

Amen? So I always wanna be prepared. I always wanna do things in excellence. And sometimes Satan makes sure that I hear things that makes me feel bad, that I've maybe not gone as high in excellence with something as I need to go. You understand where I'm coming from? Yes. Do you know what took me about two or three days to get rid of that thought in my mind? I even came and I shared that with Brian. And he said, what's, what's, you know, what's going on with you today? I said, well, I'm thinking about something. And I shared it with him. He said, well, you know, you know, you shouldn't be thinking about that. And he's right. I shouldn't be thinking about that. And you know what? Y'all shouldn't be thinking about it either. Amen. Amen. Because it's a negative thought. Because Satan knows how powerful we are when our thought life is right?

(00:26:36):

And I don't know what it might be with you, but you know, he uses those kind of things. So what do you say tonight when you talk to yourself and you say, why, pastor? Because what you say to yourself matters. And what I say to myself matters more than we could ever, ever imagine. It really does. So we gotta be careful what we're saying to ourselves. No one is, I wrote this, no one is more influential in your life than you are. Think about that for a second. Nobody is more influential in your life than you are. Why? Because nobody talks to you more than you talk to yourself.

(00:27:24):

Think about that for a second. Nobody talks to you. You may think they do, but nobody talks to you more than you talk to yourself. Therefore, you are the most influential person that you know. The sad part is, many of us are talking to ourselves in a way that makes our life absolutely miserable. There are Christians out there that are talking to their self, and they're talking to their self in a very negative way. And you listen to 'em, everything out of their mouth most of the time is negative. There are some people that you don't want to be around because every time you're around them, the record never changes. They're always negative. They're what I call professional negative people. They have a degree in negativity. And listen, the longer you hang around folks like that, the more they'll drag you down. That's right. And I've come to this conclusion, sometimes you try to help those negative people.

(00:28:36):

And if you're a Christian, you want to help people. Amen. I, this may sound mean to you, but I mean it, I have got a limited time on this earth. I have a limited time before Jesus comes back to take me home, or he calls me home. I have to make everyday count. I have to make every hour, every minute of my life count. And I want to spend time and where God wants me to spend. There are some people, I'm not saying here in this church, but there are some people down that have come into my life sometimes as a pastor that do not want to be helped. They have come to me for counseling, and I have talked to them about all kinds of things in their life. And I can talk to them today, six months later, I can talk to them about the same thing, because they're in the same way that they were six months ago.

(00:29:32):

And no matter what I say, no matter what the Holy Spirit tells them, no matter how much they read their Bible or they pray, they want to be in the same place in life that they want to be. And that isn't a negative spot. So if you've made up your mind tonight to be in a negative spot, this probably isn't the message for you all right? Because you've already determined where you want to be in life, but your mind in your life, and my life is shaped by our thoughts, whether we wanna say it or not. So guess what, with God's power, we have, think about this. Now, with God's power, we have a hundred percent control of our thoughts. A hundred percent, not 99%. We have a hundred percent control over our thoughts. Satan cannot grab our thoughts. It's impossible. He cannot. He can influence, but he cannot control your thoughts.

(00:30:35):

He can't control mine. You know how we think about negative thoughts? We can't blame those negative thoughts on Satan. Negative thoughts are gonna come as long as we're on this earth. Amen. But only us, we choose what we're gonna allow into our minds to think about. Negative thoughts are poison, absolute poison. Not only to you, to me, but to everybody else around us. You think about moms and dads, that all they do is talk about negative things in their house. Kids hear it. What happens to the kids? They get negative. What happens to everybody around people's cubicles at work when everybody talks negative all the time, people around them become negative. It's like a hand grenade when it goes off. It's got shrapnel. Your negativity in my negativity has shrapnel. It's gonna hit other people around us. And most importantly, Satan's gonna make sure that our negatively hits people that don't know Jesus as Lord and Savior. I share with somebody today, I said, listen, right now, right now, you're the only Bible that your family is reading.

(00:31:45):

You're it. Never thought about it that way. True. You're the only Bible that your family is reading right now. Why? Because your family's not reading the real Bible. You know what they're reading? They're reading you. They're reading you to see if you are the real deal. You could tell everybody all day long

that you're a Christian. Listen, talk's cheap. They're looking at your walk. They're looking at my walk. They're interesting in our words. Do you back it up? You know, that's what they're looking at. I had a a, a phrase that or a little something that I had years ago. And I, I pulled it out here for tonight. And it, it's an excellent little thing, and I advise you to take it and if you can, to find it on the internet and copy it off and, and put it somewhere. Okay?

(00:32:39):

It's, it's called attitude. Okay? One word, attitude. And it's by Charles Swindoll or Chuck. We know him as Chuck Swindoll. Okay? He's passed on now. He's, he's with the Lord. But it's a great thing about attitude. Listen to this. It says, the longer I live, the more I realize the impact of attitude on life. Attitude, to me is more important than facts. It's more important than the past, than education, than money, than circumstances, than failures, than successes, than what other people think or say or do. It's more important that appearance, giftedness or skill, it will make or break a company, a church, or a home. The remarkable thing is, we have a choice every day regarding the attitude we embrace for that day. We cannot change our past. We cannot change the fact that people will act in a certain way. We cannot change the inevitable.

(00:33:43):

The only thing we can do is play the one string we have. And that is our attitude. I am convinced that life is 10% of what happens to me and 90% of how I react to it. Amen. And so it is with you. We're in charge of our attitudes. And again, that is attitudes by Chuck Swank. I advise you to get ahold of it because it's just really, really super good. I keep it around me. So I can look at that a lot of times. So I won't have a tube. I'll have a good attitude. Amen. All right. Well, let's start in our notes tonight. All right? Says, your attitude is actually more important than your challenges in life. Think about that. Your attitude is more important than any challenge that you'll ever, ever face in life. While we saying that, because of our attitude is right, if our attitude is right with the Lord, if our attitude is right with Him, then our attitude is victorious.

So it doesn't make any difference what challenge comes our way. Amy, how did David defeat Goliath? His attitude was right. How did Moses part the Red Sea? His attitude was right. How did Joshua lead the, the children of Israel? The way he did? His attitude was right. How have you done the remarkable things that you've done in your life of the glory and honor of the Lord? Because your attitude has been right. Right? Amen. All right, let's look at a verse. You all know this verse, but I'm taking this, and I don't use this version a lot, the amplified Bible, cuz I, I really like how it kind of works. This first here it says, I can do all things, which he has called me to do. Now think about that before. He's called you to do it. He's given you the power to do it.

Do. You know why he does that? So that we always know who's God? Mm-Hmm. <affirmative>. If you never step out of the boat, you don't ever know who he really is. Those folks, when that boat, they didn't experience what Peter experienced. They couldn't because they didn't get outta the boat. That's the way it is with a lot of Christians. Well, a lot of Christians sit there and they say, I can't. I can't walk on the water. Who says, did he call you to walk on the water? Peter had a choice. He could have sat there and said, I can't do that. Are you nuts? No. What got him out of the boat? One word. Faith. He had faith in the person that called him. Do you have faith in the person that calls you to meet the challenges that come upon you? There is no challenge that you and I will ever face in life that we're not able to conquer through his power.

(00:37:44):

I don't care what it is. It doesn't make any difference. You name the biggest challenge you've got in life. You and God, you plus God equals majority in every single situation. Every one of them, it says through Him, who strengthens not only gives you strength, but he also empowers you to what? Fulfill his purpose. He's called you to the purpose. So what does he do? He equips you. Well, pastor, I don't have this. I don't have. Who says you don't? You're saying you don't. He says you do. So are you gonna believe you or him? Hey. Amen. Come on now. It takes away all of our, I can't right there in that one verse and those other verses we could use, but we don't have a leg to stand on if we're using that and if he calls us to do something. Ah, pastor, well, let me give you another verse then. All right. Give you another verse. Verse Corinthians chapter 10, verse 13. There's no temptation, there's no fault, there's no challenge, there's no issues. Regardless of its source, regardless of where it comes from, has overtaken and enticed you. That is not common to human experience. In other words, well, I don't know what pastor, if anybody's ever gone through what I've gone through. Well, yes they have. And isn't it better to think about the things God wants us to think about and have joy than it is to be gloom and doom all the time and have the negative stuff I put down situations, solutions to our challenges, issues in life come when our focus is totally on God. That's when we get the solution. That's when we get the victory. Did you hear what I said though? It comes when our focus is totally a hundred percent on him. I can't comes when our focus is half on God and half on our challenge or issue in life. Did you get that? Yes. Half focus equals no victory. You can't be double minded. Bible says that a double minded man, a double minded woman, is unstable in all of your ways.

(00:44:09):

You can't think on God and think on the problem and let the problem have the same amount of focus. Because if you do, you're gonna be unstable. Sometimes you're gonna think positive, some things, you're gonna allow the negative thing to keep playing over in your mind. So you've gotta make up that decision. If you make up that decision and give your thoughts to God, he'll take care of 'em. Number two, in your God, does not want us to be afraid or discouraged in the face of difficulties. Did you get that? Yes. It's impossible. If you are always thinking about negative thoughts and things that drain your spiritual power, when the situation, circumstances, challenges arise, you're not gonna be able

to fight. It's just like a battery. If you have a battery and that battery has a slow drain on it, a slow drain, and maybe it slow drains all night long and you go out there in the morning to start your car or your truck and it won't start. You're ready to run, but your car or truck isn't. Why? Because the battery's dead. That's the same way it is. When challenges and situations come our way that we need to conquer. He says, there is a way for success. And you know what the way of success is? Meditate on him day and night. Because if you do your thought, life's gonna be right. And we can conquer anything that comes our way on our journey.
