We want to remind you about some basic building security at Comox United.

- Please ensure your entry door (south or main level) is locked following the arrival of your participants regardless of the time of your meeting.
- As all user groups have their own key, please lock on exiting regardless of who else may be in the building.
- If you notice anything broken, for example a light burned out, please send a note to the office (admin@comoxunitedchurch.com) and Lorna will send the property management coordinator a message
- There are two First Aid Kits in the building, one in the main kitchen on top of the fridge, and one in the "Mens' Shed" room L6 on the lower floor
- The AED (automated external defibrillator) is in the main Hall - on the main floor, by the stairs to the lower and upper floors.

An urgent situation has arisen for two New Ukrainian families in the Comox Valley who are at risk of being homeless:

Family 1 is: Mom (Yulia) Dad (Sergii) Stas(16), Kirill(14) Artyom(11) and Anya(5). This is a beautiful family ready to do what they can to make a life here in the Comox Valley. They need to leave their host family by March 1, 2023.

Family 2:

A Ukrainian family from Odessa is arriving on the island on Feb 12th and would appreciate finding a host here in the Valley as soon as possible. They have temporary accommodation in Qualicum Beach but need a local host family to assist them for a few months while they get settled. The parents both speak a bit of English. The Kutsak family of 5 is comprised of: Nicolai, Dad 33, construction professional Yana, Mum 27, chef Liubov, Grandmother 50, cleaner/dishwasher ,Nikoli, Daughter 4.5,Timofey, Son 1.5

We are seeking some way of housing these two very vulnerable families.
