RULES & GUIDELINES

People's Choice will determine the bragging rights for New Song's Best Chili in the World cook-off. Guests will vote by donating money to a contestant's chili.

Preparation:

- Contestants can set up their equipment and decorations anytime between 8:00 am – 10:00 am on the cook-off day.
- An electrical outlet will be available for each entry, and a crockpot or other warming container is recommended.
- Ingredients may be pre-cooked before the commencement of the official cook-off. The cooking period must occur at least 48 hours before the event.
- The contestant must prepare chili using their selected recipe and ingredients. They must also supply all their serving utensils and containers for holding the chili.
- Spoons, tasting cups, and napkins for use in serving chili to the general public will be provided, as well as a donation jar.
- Condiments will not be provided. You are welcome to bring additional "toppings" to accompany your chili, such as cheese, crackers, sour cream, etc.
