### WHAT IS THE ENDOWMENT FUND AT ALC?

The ALC Endowment Fund is a ministry that is largely unknown to many of us. This Fund assists important elements of ALC without impacting the annual budget.

The ALC Endowment Fund was initiated to encourage supporters to make legacy gifts to our church. These gifts are used to further ALC's mission and other ministries as well as worthy organizations outside of ALC that benefit the community.

The ALC Endowment Fund operates within specific guidelines to ensure that our donations perpetuate the capital in the Fund. Only earnings from a specific time period are available for donations each year. Emphasis is placed on sound fiscal management to ensure that funds are placed in outreach ministries, internal development areas, and capital improvements. Examples of how funds have been distributed include the following: scholarships for students attending a Christian school (under-graduate and graduate) which included the ALC preschool; supporting the Sheep Dog Resiliency Conference; helping our community with donations to Agape House and other organizations.

This is NOT a solicitation for funds at this time, but rather to inform ALC members of the Endowment Fund and its function.
