- This book can serve as a reminder of key insights from “The Universal Christ” which we studied three years ago as a way to become acquainted with Rohr’s work for the first time.

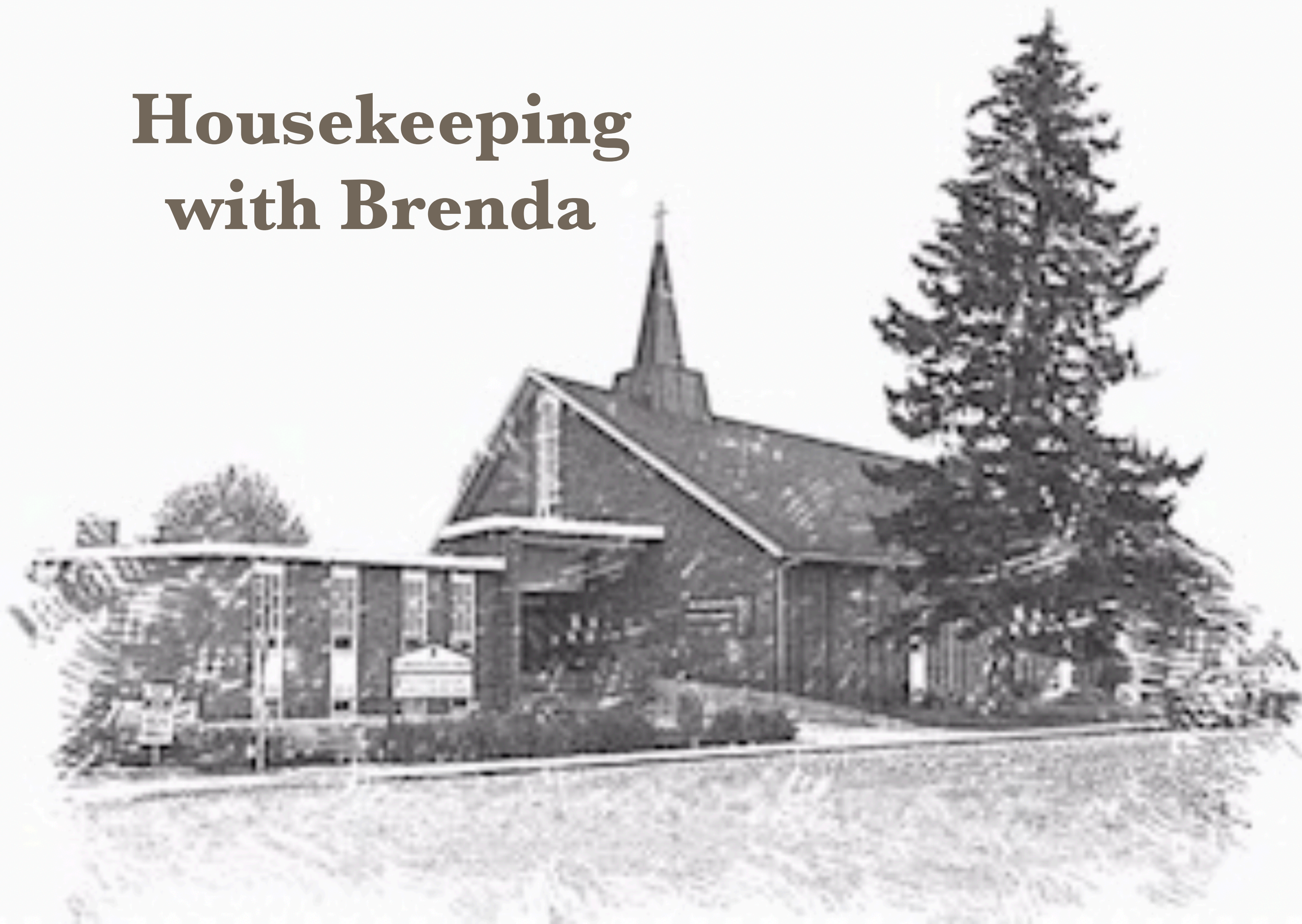
