# The Lord will Provide: What Kind of Sacrifices Do I Need to Make? Genesis 22:1-24

We are told that success comes when we make the right sacrifices. How many times do people make a sacrifice but it doesn't work out? How many times do people sacrifice something really important for something less important? Is success in life dictated by our ability to make the right sacrifices? Is God's love for us dependent on whether we make the right sacrifices? How much sacrifice is needed for God to love us? We will look at that today.

- 1. Abraham and the Willingness to Sacrifice Everything to Know God (Genesis 22:3-19)
- 2. God and the Rebuke of our Sacrifice Thinking

A. People think that they need to make the right sacrifices for God to love them; pagans make sacrifices to please the "gods"; even secular people make sacrifices to get the favor of "the universe"

- B. God doesn't want most of our sacrifices (Matthew 9:12-13)
- C. The New Testament uses the word sacrifice: negatively, informationally, to explain what Jesus did, and to show the few sacrifices God still desires
- D. There are only three types of sacrifice God wants from us: Romans 12:1; Hebrews 13:15 (and 1 Peter 2:5); Hebrews 13:16
- E. The point: Your sacrifices will not make God love you more. This is a major application of Genesis 22.
- God and the Ultimate Sacrifice of Himself

Hebrews 10:12-14

Hebrews 11:17-19

Romans 3:22b-25

Are you trying to find God's acceptance through the sacrifices you make? Or are you resting in the one sacrifice God has already made? Believe in Jesus Christ and know that, in Him, you have the acceptance and love of God and the rest your soul needs.
