Psalm 127:1-6 "Unless the Lord builds the house, They labor in vain who build it; Unless the Lord guards the city (Your home), the watchman stays awake in vain. 2 It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows; For so He gives His beloved sleep. 3 Behold, children are a heritage from the Lord, The fruit of the womb is a reward. 4 Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, so are the children of one's youth. 5 Happy is the man who has his quiver full of them; They shall not be ashamed, but shall speak with their enemies in the gate."

Psalm 128:1-6 "Blessed is <u>every one</u> who fears the Lord, Who walks in His ways.

2 When you eat the labor of your hands, You shall be happy, and it shall be well with you. 3 Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine in the very heart of your house, your children like olive plants all around your table. 4 Behold, thus shall the man be blessed who fears the Lord. 5 The Lord bless you out of Zion, and may you see the good of Jerusalem all the days of your life. 6 Yes, may you see your children's children (Grandchildren). #### 1. Prayer, Devotion and Church

Psalm 127:1 "Unless the Lord builds the house, they labour in vain who build it ..."

Deuteronomy 11:18-21 "... 19 You shall teach them to your children, speaking of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up ... 21 that your days and the days of your children may be multiplied in the land ..."

Proverbs 6:22 "When you roam, they (God's Words) will lead you; When you sleep, they will keep you; And when you awake they will speak to you."



#### 2. Family Boundaries

Proverbs 22:6 "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when He is old he will not depart from it!"

- Training means to teach by example (1 Cor.1:1)
- Help your children develop healthy boundaries
- Guard what is brought into your family
- Live the healthy boundaries as a family

Prov.28:2 "Where there is moral rot within a nation (home), it's government (family) topples easily. But with wise and knowledgeable leaders (parents), there is stability."

Psalm 128:1 "Blessed is everyone who fears the Lord, who walk is His ways."



## 3. Love & respect your spouse well

Ephesians 5:33 "Nevertheless let each one of your in particular so love his own wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband."

## 5. Communicate, listen and play to

Psalm 127:4 "Like arrows in the hand of a warrior so are the children of one's youth. 5 Happy is the man who has a quiver full of them."

- Have family/community time with your family
- Find ways to interact with each child and together as a family
- 'Stop trying to perfect your child, but keep trying to perfect your relationship with them." Dr.Henker
