

The Prayer Room is utilized throughout the week for a variety of Prayer Offerings: Tuesday Miracle Prayer Time, Praying Our Loses Prayer Group, WOW prayer time and classes, and as a "Cry Room" during Church Services for parents with babies. It is also decorated with many different pieces that have been given and worked on by former and current members. The mural above the altar was painted by ALC members Laura and Becky Greseth. The cross in the center of the mural was made by Todd Weber. The kneeling altar was built by Bob Brammer. The two 42" x 42" antique stained-glass windows were donated by ALC member Ann Brandt. She purchased the windows from Henry Trost's home in El Paso, Texas. Mr. Trost was the architect who designed The Hassayampa Hotel in Prescott in 1927. The Prayer Room is also adorned with an oil painting by ALC member Jerene Jacobson and a quilt titled "Peace" hand made by ALC member Nyla Paulsen in 2002. The picture of Jesus with a crown of thorns was donated by ALC member Cindy Lazzari. The Good Shepherd print was donated by Ray and Dee Isham in memory of their son Michael.
