#### Read Mark 11:20-25 and Matthew 5:23-26

- 1. What are the responsibilities that Jesus gives to his followers, in each passage? Who are we to forgive? Why are we supposed to forgive?
- 2. What are some of the barriers that we encounter when it comes to offering or asking for forgiveness?

### Read Matthew 18:15-17

- 3. What does Jesus teach about the process of forgiveness in this passage? Do you think that this is a practical way to approach resolving a conflict?
- 4. It can be very difficult to try to resolve conflicts with others. Are there any tips you could share about how to approach those kinds of situations (seeking forgiveness and reconciliation)? What have you found doesn't work?
