

As we go into the coming week let us daily pray;

That we will walk in love as Jesus demonstrated so that the people we reach out to may be moved to want what we have.

Please pray for our brothers and sisters facing persecution especially when they are faced with choosing between following Jesus and peace and prosperity.

"If anything happens to my pastor, I will not fear. I will take charge of pastor's work and serve the Lord!" declared 14-year-old Samaru Madkami. It was no idle comment, for Samaru's pastor was in real danger and Samaru was already active in ministry, sharing the Gospel with other young people and children in his village in Odisha state, India. He and his family had taken the decision to follow Christ about three years earlier and Samaru was, in the words of his pastor, "a passionate Christian".

At one time there had been 13 Christian families in Kenduguda village. But persecution had driven most of them away so that by June 2020 there were only four Christian families left. Samaru's father, a church elder, had received death threats, and Samaru's older cousin, Unga, had twice experienced God's deliverance when attacked: the first time, extremists had tried to tie him up in a jute bag and throw him in the river, and the second time a knifewielding gang had abducted him and threatened to kill him. Pastor Bijay, however, as the leader of the little group of believers, was clearly the main target. But in the end neither his pastor, nor his father, nor his older cousin had the honour of dying for Christ. That great privilege was granted to Samaru himself.

Soon after he had made his brave declaration about carrying on the Kingdom work if his pastor were to be martyred, Samaru went missing. After two days, on 6 June 2020, his horribly mutilated body was found by the police. A gang had persuaded Samaru to come to a meeting in the jungle. There they had tortured him before slitting his throat, smashing his head with a rock and burying his body.

Today: Pieter & Rachel Viljoen 12th March: JD & Izelle Steenkamp Ministry of the Word is a training course equipping people to give Bible talks in a variety of contexts. Using the latest module from The Way (produced by the Reformed Theological College) these 10 monthly training sessions will provide some of the core skills in studying the Word, crafting a message, and delivering a talk. Training will take place online in the evening and the cost for the full course is \$50 per participant.

Each month participants will prepare for the training session by watching some online videos, presented by men experienced in preparing and delivering messages from God's Word. This preparation will take about 60 mins. During the training sessions we will further discussing what we have learned through these videos and begin putting this into practise. Each training session will go for about 90 mins.

Ministry of the Word is designed for everyone who is currently engaged in this work and wants to grow their skills, those who want to be equipped to use their gifts in the future, and those considering full time ministry of the Word.

#### PLEASE GIVE IN CHRIST'S NAME.

Some 50,000 people have perished in the 6 Feb. Türkiye and Syria massive Earthquake. Thousands are still missing and millions of people are homeless in the bitter cold of winter. The need is overwhelming. Yet we can give help to some.

Word Transform would like to suggest to all our churches to encourage their members to consider directing their giving towards a great diaconal response that is being focused on Syria.

We chose Syria because resources are going to Türkiye, but not as much in Syria where the economic conditions are even more severe.

We chose Syria because there has already been 12 years of fighting there. Their suffering is intense.

Through the work of the Middle East Reformed Fellowship (MERF) we know that wonderful diaconal assistance will be given in Jesus' name.

MERF have brothers and sisters in Christ on the ground in Aleppo and Latakia and are providing: blankets, warm clothing, nappies, hygiene products, powdered milk and tins of food.

While we know that MERF is not a relief organization, yet we chose MERF because: there are local churches who are providing diaconal assistance in Christ's name. No staff are being "hired" to do this ministry

They participate

in the distribution on a voluntary and sacrificial basis.100% of all donations designated as "Syria EQ" will go earthquake victims.

for the women who will travel to be together for this weekend, that God would prepare their hearts to hear his word for them, and that the retreat would be a time of


connection, relaxation, laughter and growth.
