




When you are faced with a desperate situation, we need to follow the example of Jairus, to rush to Jesus, humbly bow before His lordship and simply call on Him for help.

Point #1

A DIVINE DISTRACTION

Just then a woman who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak. 21 She said to herself, "If I only touch his cloak, I will be healed."22 Jesus turned and saw her. "Take heart, daughter," he said, "your faith has healed you." And the woman was healed at that moment.




The distraction you think is God's ignoring you in fact His way of strengthening your faith. Delays in Gods answer is not His denial.




