Dear Friends,

After the Shabbat meal on Friday night, everyone settled down in the lounge area of Zula to hang out. Chen,* one of our Israeli guests, began sharing with me (Jenna) about her life and beliefs. The conversation turned to prayer, and she told me that women within Judaism don't often pray because it is normally the men who pray and typically only from the Siddur (the prayer book). After inquiring about her observations, she asked me if and how I pray. The Lord prompted me to share with her that I come directly to Him in prayer because of Jesus and that He is my Abba (meaning "father" in Hebrew). The next day the Lord would give me an opportunity to display this type of prayer life to her boyfriend.



As we all went to bed that evening, the Zula lost access to water. We had eight guests, four volunteers, ourselves, and the owners of the property in need of running water. I'm sure you could imagine the panic we felt over having so many people and no water. Shabbat was spent trying to rectify this problem and informing our guests that they would likely not be able to take showers until the following day. During this chaos, I felt the Lord prompting me to stop and pray. I invited the people who were standing with me in that moment to join me in asking our Father to provide water and a solution to the problem. Stephen, the volunteers, and Eli* (Chen's boyfriend) joined me to pray.

The water was eventually restored, and everyone was able to shower. I only assume that Chen and Eli shared these moments with each other, and I'm trusting God to use this experience to draw them to Himself. Please join me in praying that they saw our faith on display and that they would come to believe that God wants a relationship with them where they too can pray to Him as their Abba. Pray that they would come to know their Messiah and the God of Israel.
