Wayumi (pronounced why/YOU/me) is a word that Yanomamo Indians use to describe leaving their woods or home to go to another place for a period of time and for a specific purpose. It is similar to when we say we are going on a trip or on vacation, etc. Attending a Wayumi retreat is like going on an adventure in cross-cultural missions. Dan and Kathy desire to connect young adults who are searching for a purpose and ready for a challenge with Wayumi in hopes that the experience will not only strengthen their walk with the Lord but also help them discover something that is worth giving their lives for.
