


PRE-COVID REALITY

FEAR + WORRY = DOUBT






CHALLENGING TIMES! Barna Group Research

- 1 in 5 churches could close as a direct result of COVID - 16-22% of active church goers have stopped attending any church - 51% of mainline pastors

have thought about quitting

THE GREAT DEPRESSION 1929






THE GREAT DISRUPTION 2020

Attitude Differences Separate
Growing and Declining Churches

#1 Difference: We Can vs. We Can't The biggest difference I see between growing churches and declining churches is the attitude around what's possible. Growing churches believe they can. Declining churches believe they can't. They're both right. - - - Growing churches make a way when there's no way, which seems to be what God specializes in if you read the Bible.

Believe that the Spirit is up to something significant in their congregation!

Eight Virtues of Rapidly Growing Churches: Byassee and Miofsky

"In small towns and big cities, in wealthy churches and poor ones. In multisite megachurches and in rural four-point charges. Miracles are happening. Here is the difference: some churches and leaders live, work and act like they believe this, and others don't. This distinction makes all the difference.

Talk to any of the pastors we interviewed, and you will instantly see that before there was any evidence that a church would work, these pastors believed that God was up to something, that God was going to do something significant. They were determined to be a part of it. Acting as if the Spirit is moving changes everything."






