Taking Out a Library Book

The adult library is upstairs by the restrooms. Please sign out your books by adding the month and the year, and your name on the card in the back of the book. Please place the card in the display holder on the first bookshelf.

The junior library is downstairs near the washroom. Please sign out your books by adding the month and the year, and your name on the card in the back of the book. Please place the card in the display holder on the first bookshelf of the adult library upstairs.

There is no time limit on how long you can keep the books, but we occasionally check to see how you are coming along if it gets to be a few months. When you are done with the book, place it in one of the return boxes beside the adult library.

The children's library is in the rolling cart. The books are for use while at church, so there are no cards to sign out.

We cull the books every couple of years, withdrawing those that have not been signed out for some time, making room for books new to our library. We accept donations of books that are in good condition and have suitable content. However, any book that has been in the library previously, or does not meet the purpose of the library, will be donated to the Tilly.

If you have not read a book for a while, I would highly recommend it. The feel of a hard copy book is a more relaxing and engaging reading experience than an e-reader or online book. Just saying!
