The Power and Place of Prayer

All through the Bible and in history, we see that prayer precedes revival and great works of God. In the Book of Acts, we read,

"Then they returned to Jerusalem from the hill called the Mount of Olives, a Sabbath day's walk from the city. When they arrived, they went upstairs to the room where they were staying. Those present were Peter, John, James and Andrew; Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew; James son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot, and Judas son of James. They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers" (Acts 1:12-14).

The amazing evangelistic revival and work of the Holy Spirit that come in Acts 2 are clearly connected to the prayers of God's people. What a joy to see a biblical portrait of God's people, men and women, together in passionate prayer, and then to discover that the Spirit descended in power, the gospel was proclaimed, and over three thousand people gave their hearts and lives to Jesus!

One of the most powerful things you can do to grow in your personal commitment to outreach is to pray for those who are not yet followers of Christ. Make a list of friends, family members, and acquaintances who are not Christians. Put this list where you will see it and pray for one or more of these people each day. Then be sure to ask God to help you be responsive to the opportunities he gives you to use your unique evangelism style to connect with them, love them, and speak to them about Jesus.

Prayer must bathe everything we do, especially when it comes to the ministry of outreach. Every follower of Jesus should be praying for their friends, family members, and acquaintances who don't know Jesus. We also need to undergird all of our outreach efforts with prayer.

Along with praying for our churches' outreach efforts, it is critical that followers of Jesus discover the power of praying for and with those spiritual seekers God has placed in our lives. Through the years, I have asked many nonbelievers, "Can I pray for you?" So far no one has said no. It is amazing how people who don't have faith in God can still hunger for prayer.

Dear Friends,

When I was young, I remember working on farm equipment with my father, grandfather, and uncles. Sometimes a bolt or part of the equipment would be "stuck" and could not be loosened by the strength of one person. When that happened, often two or three people would grab a wrench, connect a long bar to the wrench for leverage, and we would all push together until what was stuck would break loose. When what was stuck finally broke loose, we experienced incredible joy.

January 22, 2023, I'm asking the Church of God of Prophecy in North America to PUSH together in prayer. When we PUSH together, we are committing to Pray Until Something Happens. We will pray until the bolt breaks loose or until we are broken. We pray for God to open doors of ministry and anoint us to walk through them, or for him to make us willing to go. God, give us a breakthrough and break us for those who are lost. Break us for the needs around us. God, break us for what breaks your heart.

At the beginning of each new year, the global Church of God of Prophecy family devotes 21 days to prayer and seeking God's face. We want to see North America conclude the 2023 season of seeking with a prayer PUSH like never before. I'm asking every Church of God of Prophecy congregation in North America to designate Sunday, January 22, 2023, as a day to pray until something happens. I hope every congregation will have a prayer meeting on that day or evening, seeking God together.

On January 22, 2023, would you PUSH together in prayer for the following five areas of ministry in North America,

- <u>PUSH with me in prayer for anointing to reach the unreached in our communities with</u> <u>the message of Jesus.</u> Throughout my lifetime, we have prayed for and sent missionaries around the world. Now, God is sending the world to us. Let's join in prayer for the anointing to reach those around us.
- <u>PUSH with me in prayer for ministry to the least of these.</u> Our communities are full of people in need. Let's pray for God's grace to serve the underserved and neediest in our cities and communities. Let's pray for an anointing to be the hands and feet of Jesus to those in need.
- PUSH with me in prayer for divine healing to operate in our congregations. Jesus is our healer. Let's have special prayer for those among us who need physical healing, and let's believe for miracles!
- <u>PUSH with me in prayer for church planters and church planting.</u> We are asking God to send laborers into his harvest for church planting in North America, and we are praying for mother churches to emerge to facilitate this great need.



 Finally, PUSH with me in prayer for new ministers. We are experiencing an explosion of young ministers in North America who are hearing and responding to God's call. Let's pray for God's anointing upon them and for ministry mentors to step forward and prayerfully mentor them as they reach the harvest.

Sunday, January 22, 2023, will be a prayer PUSH for North America. I can't wait to see all God has in store for us as we Pray Until Something Happens together. God, give us a breakthrough and break us to surrender to all you are doing. I hope you'll share testimonies of all God did in your prayer meetings on social media using the hashtag #PrayerPUSH. Let's testify of God's goodness as we push together in prayer on Sunday, January 22, 2023.

Quand j'étais jeune, je me souviens avoir travaillé sur des équipements agricoles avec mon père, mon grand-père et mes oncles. Parfois, un boulon ou un élément de l'équipement se retrouvait " bloqué " et ne pouvait être desserré par la force d'une seule personne. Dans ce cas, il arrivait souvent que deux ou trois personnes s'emparent d'une clé à molette et y fixent une longue barre pour servir de levier, puis nous poussions tous ensemble jusqu'à ce que l'objet bloqué se détache. Lorsque ce qui était coincé se libérait enfin, nous éprouvions une joie incroyable.

Le 22 janvier 2023, j'invite l'Église de Dieu de la Prophétie en Amérique du Nord à « POUSSER » ensemble dans la prière. Lorsque nous prions ensemble, nous nous engageons à prier jusqu'à ce que quelque chose se produise. Nous prierons jusqu'à ce que le boulon se desserre ou jusqu'à ce que nous expérimentions un brisement. Nous prions pour que Dieu ouvre les portes du ministère et nous oigne pour les franchir, ou pour qu'il nous donne la volonté de nous engager. Au début de chaque nouvelle année, toute la famille de l'Église de Dieu de la Prophétie à travers le monde consacre 21 jours à la prière et à la recherche de la face de Dieu. Cette année, j'ai demandé à l'Amérique du Nord de conclure ces 21 jours de recherche de Dieu par un temps de prière PUSH comme jamais auparavant. Je demande à chaque congrégation de l'Église de Dieu de la Prophétie en Amérique du Nord de décréter que le dimanche 22 janvier 2023 sera un jour de prière jusqu'à ce que quelque chose se produise. Je souhaite que chaque congrégation organise une réunion de prière ce jour-là ou ce soir-là, pour chercher Dieu ensemble pour l'Amérique du Nord.

(Remarque : " PUSH " - Pray Until Something Happens ("Priez jusqu'à ce que quelque chose se produise") est l'acronyme anglais désignant cette initiative. PUSH signifie POUSSER en français.)

Le 22 janvier 2023, voulez-vous prier ensemble pour les 5 domaines de ministère suivants concernant l'Amérique du Nord,

 Pour l'onction pour atteindre les non-atteints de nos communautés avec le message de Jésus. Tout au long de ma vie, nous avons prié pour et envoyé des missionnaires dans le monde entier. Maintenant, Dieu fait venir le monde jusqu'à nous. Joignons-nous dans la prière pour l'onction afin d'atteindre ceux qui nous entourent.



- Pour le ministère auprès des plus petits. Nos communautés sont pleines de personnes dans le besoin. Prions pour la grâce de Dieu afin de servir les plus démunis et les plus nécessiteux dans nos villes et nos communautés. Prions pour l'onction afin d'être les mains et les pieds de Jésus pour ceux qui sont dans le besoin.
- 3. <u>Pour que la guérison divine opère dans nos congrégations</u>. Jésus est notre guérisseur. Ayons une prière spéciale pour ceux parmi nous qui ont besoin de guérison physique, et croyons aux miracles !
- 4. <u>Pour les implanteurs d'églises et pour l'œuvre d'implantation d'églises.</u> Nous demandons à Dieu d'envoyer des ouvriers dans sa moisson pour l'implantation d'églises en Amérique du Nord, et nous prions pour que des églises mères émergent pour faciliter ce grand besoin.
- 5. <u>Enfin, Pour les nouveaux ministres.</u> Nous vivons une explosion de jeunes ministres en Amérique du Nord, qui entendent et répondent à l'appel de Dieu. Prions pour que l'onction de Dieu soit sur eux et que des mentors du ministère s'avancent et les encadrent dans la prière alors qu'ils atteignent la moisson.

Le dimanche 22 janvier 2023 aura lieu un événement de prière intitulé PUSH en faveur de l'Amérique du Nord. J'ai hâte de voir tout ce que Dieu nous réserve alors que nous nous efforçons ensemble de prier jusqu'à ce que quelque chose se produise. O Dieu, donne-nous une percée, et brise-nous pour que nous nous abandonnions à tout ce que tu fais. J'espère que vous partagerez les témoignages de tout ce que Dieu a fait dans vos réunions de prière sur les médias sociaux en utilisant le hashtag #PrayerPUSH. PRAYER GUIDE

FROM COGOP INTERNATIONAL Week 1



Week One January 2-8, 2023 Core Value Target: Prayer Global Family Targets: Africa, Asia, Europe/CIS/Middle East

Jesus said, "My house will be called a house of prayer" (Matthew 21:13 NIV). Scripture tells us that the early church was "devoted to prayer" (Acts 1:14; 2:42; 6:4). It is the desire of the Father that every church today be the same. Becoming a people devoted to prayer requires more than programs and good intentions. It requires a faithful, intentional obedience in seeking the Father daily. This week, we invite you to join us daily as we petition the Father that our churches would be "houses of prayer" and that as individuals we would be devoted to prayer.

Week One Prayer Directives

- Thank the Father for his ability and readiness to give, guide, and respond in response to our prayers (Matthew 7:7, 8).
- Confess for yourself or your church any lack of devotion to prayer. Ask God to help your church and its leaders be devoted to or "diligently occupied with" prayer (Colossians 4:2, Acts 1:14; Acts 2:42; Acts 6:4).
- Ask God to help your church family pray as the needs arise, spontaneously, and to cover everything in prayer (Ephesians 6:8).
- Ask God to make you alert to needs in your church family and to "keep on praying continually" for all members of your church family (Ephesians 6:8).
- Ask the Father to help you and your church to pray as Jesus urged you to pray—continually asking, seeking, and knocking (Matthew 7:7, 8).
- Pray for power and wisdom to know the "greater things" the Father wants you and your church to do for Him (John 14:12-14).
- Ask the Father to help you see beyond just personal needs and to focus on kingdom concerns (John 14:12—14).
- Pray that your church will pray faithfully and powerfully for your city, community, nation, and leaders (1 Timothy 2:1, 2).
- Pray for your pastor and ministry leaders (Romans 15:30).
- Thank that the "hearts desire" of your church would be to pray for the unsaved and that He would give your church practical opportunities to reach out to your community (Romans 10:1; 1 Timothy 2:1, 3, 4).

FROM COGOP INTERNATIONAL Week 2



Week Two January 9-15, 2023 Core Value Target: The Harvest and Stewardship Global Family Targets: North America, Caribbean

For the Church of God of Prophecy, the Harvest has been the call heard consistently since 1994, which was really only a re-alignment to our call when this Movement was birthed. We praise God that we are an international body in 134 nations, with over 12,000 preaching points, planting two new churches every day, and participating with God to see a thousand people get saved every day. This week, we unite our prayers to ask God for continued favor and blessing as we remain faithful to His call to "Go!"

Week Two Prayer Directives

- Praise God for Jesus Christ who came to seek and save those who are lost (Luke 15:1-31; 19:9, 10).
- Give thanks for the Gospel of Jesus Christ which is the power of God for salvation to all who believe (Romans 1:16).
- Recall your personal testimony of salvation, and thank God for His deliverance (Psalm 40:1-3).
- Ask God to send forth laborers into the harvest (Matthew 9:37, 38).
- Ask God to reveal to us-individually and corporately-believers where He is working so that we may focus our efforts more effectively (John 6:44; 17:3, 15).
- Ask the Father to raise up excellent, anointed ministries to the young harvest of children and youth (Matthew 19:14; Acts 2:17).
- Intercede for unsaved individuals you know personally, and claim the following promises for them (John 14:6; Romans 10: 9-11; Matthew 18:18).
- Pray that God's kingdom will come and His will be done in individuals' hearts, families, cities, nations, and the world, even as it is in heaven (Matthew 6:9– 13; Daniel 4:34, 35).
- Pray for God's direction and discernment in our global church planting efforts (Mark 16:15).
- Ask God to grant access for the Gospel through open heavens, open minds, open hearts, and open doors (Isaiah 45:8; Acts 26:17, 18; 2 Corinthians 4:6; Colossians 4:2—3).
- Pray that grace be the basis of all stewardship and a matter of the heart (1 Peter 4:10).
- Pray that tithing and giving leads to whole-life stewardship including time, talent, health, and family (Luke 20:25, 21:4, Malachi 3:12).

Week Two Prayer Directives Continued

- Pray that children and youth will learn biblical stewardship from their parents and leaders (Matthew 7:24; Colossians 1:27, 28, 2:7; 1 Peter 5:2, 10).
- Pray that people with the spiritual gift of giving will acknowledge, understand, and practice their gift (Romans 12:6–8).
- Pray that the joy of giving becomes a reality, causing giving to go beyond being needs based (2 Corinthians 9:7).
- Pray that a scriptural understanding of debt will break the debt bondage on families (Proverbs 21:20, 17:18; Romans 13:8).
- Pray that biblical stewardship will break the addiction of materialism which leads to idolatry (Colossians 3:5).
- Pray that pastors and members will receive revelation that we tithe to Jesus, not our pastor (Hebrews 7:8–10).

FROM COGOP INTERNATIONAL Week 3



Week Three January 16-22, 2023 Core Value Target: Leadership Development Global Family Targets: Central and South America

In Harvest-rich locations, leadership development is essential so that the fields God has prepared can be penetrated even further. The model of Jesus affirms this. His ministry here on earth did not focus on His ability to reach massive numbers of people. Jesus realized that the greatest work He could do was to develop 12 solid leaders who could, in turn, develop others, spreading the leadership strength and so multiplying harvest impact in time.

Week Three Prayer Directives

- Give thanks to God for the global perspective and ministries of the Church of God of Prophecy (Acts 1:8).
- Ask God to strengthen church leadership and bless the efforts of churches and ministries where they minister (1 Timothy 2:1, 2).
- Ask God to send forth laborers into the harvest (Matthew 9:37, 38).
- Ask God to raise up leaders in intercession, worship, and servant ministries to help loose the bands of wickedness and prepare for the return of Our Lord (Isaiah 58:6—10).
- Pray that the Father would raise up anointed leaders to serve the young harvest through children's and youth ministries (Psalm 78:4).
- Pray that men, women, boys, and girls would embrace the call of God and our efforts to equip them for ministry would be successful (Jeremiah 1:5; 2 Peter 1:10, 11; Ephesian 4:12).
- Pray for those already engaged in ministry that the Holy Spirit will use them to equip his people for works of service so that the body of Christ may be built up (Ephesians 4:11—13).
