





As we go into the coming week let us daily pray;

Give praise and thanks to our dear Lord Jesus Christ for opening the way to salvation not counting the cost to himself.

Please continue to pray for Corrie van der Walt as she continues to recover from her operation, thanking God that it went well. Pray that she will recover quickly and soon be up and about.

Please pray for Herman Dyer and his family, especially his parents as Herman's sister passed away. Pray that during this time of deep mourning they may have the strength, comfort and peace that only our heavenly Father can give.

Please pray for Maria Knol's family as Maria's niece passed away from complications following child birth. Please bring this family before the Lord in prayer that he may surround them with his love.

Please pray for the Vanderjagt family as they mourn the passing of their mother, grandmother and great grandmother. Pray that the Lord will comfort them with the assurance of her salvation.

Please continue to pray for those of us battling the ravages of cancer, Martie Schachtner and Heather Linde. Pray that the Lord will be gracious and grant them both complete healing.

Please continue to pray for those we have committed to pray for that they may come to a saving knowledge of Jesus.

Please pray for our communities that the Holy Spirit will do great things wherever we live so that God's name is glorified and the lost are saved.

Please remember our brothers and sisters all kinds of terrors for their Lord and ours.

Wuwih William Gemuh, a senior Bible translator in north-west Cameroon, was kidnapped and later killed by gunmen after facilitating a workshop on 17 March. Keyeh Emmanuel, General Director of the Cameroon Association for Bible Translation and Literacy, said, "We are working to bring comfort to the family and colleagues at this very difficult moment. We invite you to be in prayers for us and for Wuwih's family." Pray that Wuwih's wife and six children will be greatly comforted as they mourn. Ask that his colleagues will receive courage and wisdom as they adjust to the void left by Wuwih, and for their protection from harm.

A worshipper was killed and a pastor was kidnapped along with three members of his congregation during an attack on a church in Benue State, Nigeria, in the early hours of Palm Sunday, 2 April. Five people were wounded in the assault by suspected Fulani Muslim extremists who stormed into the church while a prayer vigil was taking place. Pray that our Saviour will be close to the bereaved and to the families of the Christians kidnapped during the attack. Ask for healing for the wounded.

At least ten people were killed and 20 injured in Myanmar military (Tatmadaw) air strikes on the village of Khuabung, Thantlang township, in Christian-majority Chin State on 30 March. Local sources said that there was no military action in the vicinity, and the military were clearly targeting the civilian population. Ask that God will give His peace to those who lost loved ones in the assault, and that those injured will recover fully. Ask that He will restrain those intent on attacking Myanmar's Christians and bring about lasting peace.


