Committee Reports

Finance - February donations were very weak. The \$11,846 total is the fourth highest February in the last ten years, trailing a very weak 2022 (\$11,856) by \$10 while exceeding a very weak 2021 (\$10,885) by \$961. February expenses (\$18,936) were higher than 2022 by \$1,568 and higher than 2021 by \$3,063. February operations generated a \$7,090 deficit. The year-to-date deficit increased to \$18,475, the highest at the end of two months in the last twenty-five years.

Property - March 2023 Property Report to LOL Council

The following are the activities of the property committee since the last council meeting:

1. The new water cooler has been installed.

2. The recycled bench will be installed by the playground as soon as a secure location is determined by the property committee.

3. Work on the audio/visual system in the Sanctuary continues. The A/V desk has been moved to its new location and one camera is installed at its final location. One camera remains to be installed when materials are received.

4. A new 85" high definition TV has been installed.

5. The Seventh Day Adventist congregation has purchased new wireless microphones to be used in the Sanctuary.

RIC - The RIC committee met on March 7th with Pastor Adam, Connie Allekian, Andy Buda, Toni Blesy, Janet Kardatzke, Sheila Ruh, Bobbie Sejnost and Sherry Sejnost in attendance. The committee continued to discuss the book Rescuing Jesus: How People of Color, Women, and Queer Christians are Reclaiming Evangelicalism focusing on the chapter untitled Coming Out.

The next meeting will be held on April 11th at 4:00 P.M. to discuss the next chapters of the text and explore resources found on the RIC webpage. Future considerations of the committee will focus on visiting churches to become familiar with how people of color, and queer Christians worship and developing a message that welcomes and affirms all people in regard to their gender expression, gender identity, and sexual orientation.

Worship & Music Committee - The Worship & Music Committee met on March 15th. A discussion was held regarding how ushering is going and it's been better but still needs some work. Altar Guild is going well. We discussed the organ needs to be played and Pastor will work with Rosita. We discussed sending out a survey to the members asking them to list 3 or 4 of their favorite hymns. Our next meeting will be on May 10th at 11:30 AM.
