


We need to be real about our unresolved lament with God and others.

Deep sadness: Joy is gone from our hearts; our dancing has turned to mourning. (v 15)





Status change: The crown has fallen from our head. (v 16)

Lack of vision: Because of these things our eyes grow dim (v 17)










The good news of the reign of God does not begin with a triumphant military victory by an exceptional hero, but instead the good news of the reign of God is connected to a 'have-not.'...
