



1 Corinthians 2:16b (NLT) - But we understand these things, for we have the mind of Christ.

**2 Corinthians 10:5** (NASB) - We are destroying arguments and all arrogance raised against the knowledge of God, and we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ.

Romans 8:5-6 (NLT) - Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. <sup>6</sup> So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace.

Luke 24:49 (NLT) - "And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised. But stay here in the city until the Holy Spirit comes and fills you with power from heaven."
