When Jesus ascended into heaven, he didn't leave behind a written document or a system of beliefs. He left a community that would embody the message of the kingdom. Then, as now, the stories, teaching and challenges of Jesus - and how they are worked out in community - shape and build the Church. In fact, it is almost impossible to read the Bible outside of a community lens. So, while the phrase "church member" is not used in the New Testament, the concept of being identified with, committed to, and accountable to a local community of Christians is clear.

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

Membership commits us to a like-minded community.

(1 Thess 2:8, Phil 1:4-6, Gal 6:1-2)

Membership affirms that we hold to similar values and beliefs. (Rom 15:5, Eph 4:3-5, 1 Tim 4:11-16, Phil 2:1-2).

Membership ensures that we are corporately building on a strong, shared foundation of faith. In this, we want to keep our expectations as clear as possible. Membership lets the church know where you stand and, perhaps more importantly, in your own spiritual journey it enables you to examine where you stand. Read *Our Vision* and *Statement of Faith* (on the inside covers of this booklet). These are the tools that guide our community toward our basic identity and unified direction. Becoming a member requires your affirmation of these things.

Membership allows us to understand our role and the use of our time, talents, and resources for the health of the church. (1 Cor 12:4-27, Rom 12:4-13).

#### **BAPTISM**

Baptism is the essential outward expression of the inner change that has already taken place in a Christ-follower's life.
Therefore it should precede becoming a member.

Baptism is the traditional rite of a Christian's public confession of faith and membership in Christ's body. We practice full immersion in water because it identifies the believer with Jesus' death in going down into the water, and with his resurrection in coming up again. For infants, we practice baby dedication, where we join with parents in thanksgiving and as a community stand with them as they publicly declare their commitment to raise them in a loving, Christ-centred home.

## GIVING

Our life as a church is sustained by the faithful and generous contributions of many. As a church, we are committed to using all that is given in ways that faithfully sustain Lambrick and support the ministry of the gospel in our world.

There are lots of ways you can financially support our church. All will give you a tax receipt.

**IN PERSON:** You can place cash or cheque in the offering box on the wall in the commons area. To receive a tax receipt for cash donations, make sure to place them in one of the labelled envelopes that are available beside the box.

**ONLINE: PAYPAL** accepts credit and debit cards. Fees are 1.6% +30c. **CANADAHELPS** accepts credit cards. There is a 4% fee for one-time gifts, or a 3.5% fee for monthly donations. They also offer the option for you to give securities/investment funds if you wish.

**PRE-AUTHORIZED** giving is the most helpful for us, as it allows us to plan ahead, and there are no fees taken by a third party. Your regular monthly donations will be automatically paid through your chequing and/or savings account.
