#### From Nate's Pen: We Believe: In the New Testament Church

The church is not a social club. It is not a merely human organization organized around human politics or any other human interests. Rather, to use the images of the New Testament, the church is: the New Covenant People of God (Luke 22:20), the Temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 3:16), the Body of Christ (1 Cor. 12:12-13 & 27), a Pillar and Buttress of the Truth (1 Tim. 3:15), A Royal Priesthood and Holy Nation and People for God's Own Possession (1 Peter 2:9), a Community of Sojourners and

Exiles on Earth (1 Peter 2:11), and the Bride of Christ (Rev. 21:9-11).

The mission of the church is to preach the Gospel in all the world and make disciples of all nations (Matt. 28:16-20, Mark 16:14-16, Luke 24:44-49, John 20:19-23, Acts 1:1-11). In everything we do, we want to bring glory and honor to God (Eph. 1:11-14, Matt. 5:13-16, Col. 3:17, 1 Peter 2:9-12).

Further, for Christians, belonging to the church and being involved in the worship, fellowship, service, teaching, and mission of the church is not optional. It is a divine command which is essential for our personal spiritual growth, for the health of the church, and for the effectiveness of the church's ministry to the world (Eph. 2:11-22, 1 Cor. 12, Hebrews 3-4).

This coming Sunday, I will preach about the doctrine of the church from 1 Peter 2:1-12. This is a passage which is rich in Old Testament imagery. It shows the continuity between Israel and the church of Jesus Christ. This passage is also powerfully relevant to how we live out our calling as the church in an unbelieving and increasingly hostile world. I invite you to spend time reading and praying through 1 Peter 2:1-12 in preparation for this week's message. Remember, our goal is to know, love, and live the truth God has revealed to us!
