The Greater Exodus

Colossians 1:12-14 Bobby Alger April 30, 2023

1. The Exodus from Egypt set a <u>pattern</u> for the new <u>covenant</u> Exodus.

I brought you up out of Egypt and redeemed you from the land of slavery. I sent Moses to lead you... Mic 6:4

- O.T. In <u>captivity</u> by slavery of the Egyptian <u>system</u>.
 - N.T. Enslaved by the <u>sin</u> nature given from <u>Adam</u>.
- O.T. God heard the cries and took action to bring them out.
 - N.T. God promised to send a <u>Saviour</u> for our <u>sins</u>.
- O.T. Moses was the leader and mediator of the journey out.
 - N.T. <u>Jesus</u> is the pioneer and mediator of our journey out.
- O.T. Obedience was required by the flesh for freedom.
 - N.T. Obedience is required by the Spirit for freedom.
- O.T. Guilt free living granted by <u>animal</u> sacrifice and blood.
 - N.T. Guilt free living given by Jesus' sacrifice and blood.

2. Our exodus is real and our victory is sure!

Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death? Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 7:24-25 NLT

- From the enslavement of <u>sin</u> into <u>sonship</u> of the beloved Father.
 (Romans 8:14-16)
- The <u>struggle</u> is intense, but the outcome is <u>secure</u>. (Romans 7:21-25)
- The old nature is <u>dead</u>, as long as the new nature is in <u>charge</u>. (Romans 8:1-6)
- Domains of freedom include:
 - Our spirit needs deliverance. (Matthew 12:43-45)
 - Our soul <u>renewal</u> of the mind. (Romans 12:1-2)
 - Our body stewardship of what's given. (I Corinthians 6:19-20)
