The Greater Exodus

Colossians 1:12-14

1. The Exodus from Egypt set a pattern for the new covenant Exodus.

I brought you up out of Egypt and redeemed you from the land of slavery. I sent Moses to lead you... Mic 6:4

- O.T. – In captivity by slavery of the Egyptian system.
N.T. – Enslaved by the sin nature given from Adam.
- O.T. - God heard the cries and took action to bring them out.
N.T. - God promised to send a Saviour for our sins.
- O.T. – Moses was the leader and mediator of the journey out.
N.T. - Jesus is the pioneer and mediator of our journey out.
- O.T. – Obedience was required by the flesh for freedom.
N.T. – Obedience is required by the Spirit for freedom.
- O.T. – Guilt free living granted by animal sacrifice and blood.
N.T. - Guilt free living given by Jesus' sacrifice and blood.

2. Our exodus is real and our victory is sure!

Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death? Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 7:24-25 NLT

- From the enslavement of sin into sonship of the beloved Father.
(Romans 8:14-16)
- The struggle is intense, but the outcome is secure.
(Romans 7:21-25)
- The old nature is dead, as long as the new nature is in charge.
(Romans 8:1-6)
- Domains of freedom include:
 - Our spirit – needs deliverance. (Matthew 12:43-45)
 - Our soul – renewal of the mind. (Romans 12:1-2)
 - Our body – stewardship of what's given. (I Corinthians 6:19-20)
