I remember a time when I was a child around four years of age, my family was grilling hamburgers in our yard. The coals had been going for a while and the burgers were cooking. I had been warned not to touch the grill because it was very, very hot. For some reason, I had the urge to touch the grill anyway. So, I reached up with my right hand and placed it on the bottom of the grill, the spot where the coals were. I burned my hand instantly.

As I remember this event, what really strikes me about it, is that even more than the pain of the burn, even more than the embarrassment of disregarding the warning not to touch the grill, I remember the loving, gentle arms of my mother as she picked me up, kissed my hurt and rendered first aid. My mother gently rocked me and soothed me with her loving touch. There was no scolding or condemnation, just grace and love and healing.

In May we celebrate Mother's Day. This day is to honor those who carried us in their wombs for nine months, give or take. They are the ones who nurtured us throughout our lives. I am not dismissing the contributions of you Fathers. Your month is next month! A mother's love is a love like no other. It is the closest thing to God's love as we have on earth. A place where we find direction, support, love and forgiveness.

Avocado Bread by Carolyne Saxton

2 c. sugar
3/4 c. shortening
3 eggs
1 1/2 c. mashed avocado
2 2/3 c. sifted flour
3/4 c. sour milk
3/4 c. chopped nuts

3/4 c. raisins 1/2 c. chopped dates 3/4 tsp. allspice 3/4 tsp. cinnamon 3/4 tsp. salt 1 1/2 tsp. soda

Cream shortening and sugar till light and fluffy. Add 1 egg at a time, beating well. Mix in avocado. Mix flour and soda; add to avocado mixture. Stir in rest of ingredients. Mix together 1 teaspoon cinnamon and 1/4 sugar. Sprinkle over bread. Bake 1 hour at *350. Makes 2 loaves.
