Carlus is Assistant Dean, Professor of Ministry and director of the Doctor of Ministry program at Lipscomb, he was DMin Co-Director, Director of Field Education, and Professor of Ministry at Harding School of Theology (2014-2020), and professor of Church Leadership and Bible at Johnson University (2001-2013). He also taught at the University of Tennessee in

Communication Studies (2001-2011). Carlus teaches courses in church leadership, spiritual formation and conflict, and has also taught New Testament, theology and communication. He began preaching at the age of 17 and has over 45 years of experience in congregations small and large.

For over twenty-five years, Carlus has maintained an active schedule of consulting, coaching, and intentional interim ministry, having worked with over 200 churches and organizations. He is a partner of Hope Network Ministries and ICF Accredited Coach (ACC). He also holds extensive certifications in ministry transitions, strategic renewal, congregational change, self-differentiated leadership, conflict intervention, and problem-solving. He has led over 2,500 people through the DISC Profile and is an accredited practitioner with instruments such as Conflict Styles, Wagner Enneagram Spectrum, Integrative Enneagram 9, and Birkman Signature. Carlus is a graduate of the Academy for Spiritual Formation and has a passion for integrating spiritual practices and strategic initiatives such as appreciative inquiry in congregational development. Two of his special interests are empowering church leadership and navigating complex congregational change. Carlus is an energetic presenter of numerous workshops, lectures, and sermons for churches and conferences across the nation.


