

LIVING INTO OUR NEW

IDENTITY AS FAMILY MEMBERS Phil. 1:27; 2:1-1; 12-13; Mark 8:34-35

Levi Simpson spoke about some of the aspects of living into our identity as members of the family of God.

- 1. We saw that all of us have an identity from our "birth family". As a way of getting to know each other- have each group member share a little about his/her family of origin. (max 1-2 minutes)
- 2. In Phil 1:27 Paul reminds us that we have a new identity and that we are now invited to "live into" our new identity.
 - a. What are some of the aspects of our new identity?
 - b. What is involved in living into our new identity?
- 3. Jesus set the example. Re-read Phil 2:1-11
 - a. Discuss verse 3-5. What does this look like in our daily life?
 - b. Verse 6-11 How does Jesus model of living "not just his own interest but the interest of others" guide us as we become more "like our Rabbi"? (last week's invitation.)
- 4. The speaker said that we are becoming a "cruciform community"- a cross shaped community with "cross shaped people".
 - a. What does Mark 8:34-35 show us of what is involved in becoming more and more "cross-shaped"?
- 5. Phil 2:12-13 indicatess both our responsibility as well as some of what God does in our process of being changed.
 - a. What do we see about our responsibility? v.12
 - b. What do we see God doing? V.13
- 6. The speaker concluded with a question: What does it mean to be both family (add your surname) and family of God (becoming more like Jesus)? Discuss how you see this living out in your daily life
- 7. Spend some time praying for each other, specifically in the journey to become more like Jesus in every way.
