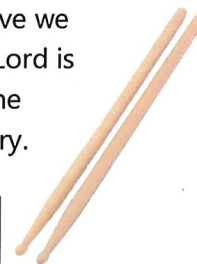
**"Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed,
