thing else or very	different from something else, so that one of them must be
wrong. A logical ii	ncongruity. Contra=in opposition / Diction—choice of words.

What many see as opposite words in the Bible are really paradoxes, a **SEEMING** contradiction.

### 2023 Theme: ABUNDANCE

Abundance is <u>TIED</u> to God's Word (Psalm 1:1-3, Matthew 7:24-27). If the devil can get you to doubt God's Word, he steals your abundance.

# **Ways the Bible is Manipulated**

### 1. <u>DISTORT</u> to support

People focus on only one side of the contradiction/paradox to support their erroneous viewpoint. They don't look at the other perspectives of the truth.

### Judge Not

<u>Luke 6:37</u>—"Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

- Contradicts other Scriptures: John 7:24; 1 Corinthians 14:29; 15:11-13
- <u>Parallel passage</u>: Matthew 7:1-5 (the context of Matthew 6:2,5,16 is hypocrisy).

Matthew 7:5—"Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye."

<u>The Context of "Judge Not"</u>—Jesus is not telling us to live without with <u>DISCERNMENT</u>. He is telling us to speak into the lives of other believers, but be very careful and never judge hypocritically.

2. Amiss So <u>DISMISS</u>

Because the Bible appears to contradict itself, means it is all untrue.

## **Keys to Finding the Real Meaning of Scripture**

- 1. Understand the <u>CONTEXT</u>: what's before and after the verse, who wrote it, to whom was it written, what's the major theme, what is God trying to say through this author? How does culture of that time period influence it?
- 2. Interpret Scripture with other SCRIPTURES: the best way to understand the Bible is with the Bible. Don't build a doctrine on one verse that contradicts the general tenor of the Word.
- **3. Apply what you <u>LEARN</u>**: The Bible is not a book to be studied as much as it is to be God's letter to us to be lived.
