# St. Paul's Breakfast Program Pilot Project – Volunteer Job Description

Holy Eucharist at 10:30 a.m.

St. Paul's Anglican Church is excited to test out a new outreach initiative in the Stratford community in the form of a free community breakfast. With the partnership of Langlois Law, we hope to offer a continental-style breakfast twice a week, on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7:30-9:30 am.

This is an opportunity to both meet a need in the wider community and to build relationships with our neighbours. Volunteer support from both our congregation and fellow churches in the Stratford community are needed to make this pilot program a success. Volunteers will be required to assist with the following tasks:

- Setting up tables and chairs
- Putting out food and drink for breakfast guests and replenishing supplies when needed
- Monitoring the use of toasters and other relevant equipment
- Visiting with breakfast guests (you are welcome to eat, too!)
- Washing dishes
- Tearing down tables and chairs, and clean-up

We are seeking to staff 5 volunteers per shift, which will last from 7 to 10 am. If any of these tasks are within your capability and you are interested in participating in this pilot project, please reach out to:
