1. What is something from the sermon that really stood out to you?
2. **Read Genesis 3:4-5.** How could the lie from the serpent also have caused Eve to question her faith in God? How does this affect her identity?
3. **Read "Satan's Lies vs God's Truth."** Which of these is easy to accept? Which do you struggle with?

<u>Satan's Lie</u>	<u>God's Truth</u>
You are sinner because you sin.	You are a saint (one declared righteous by God) who sins.
Your identity comes from what you have done.	Your identity comes from what God has done for you.
Your identity comes from what people say about you.	Your identity comes from what God says about you.
Your behavior tells you what to believe about yourself.	Your belief about yourself determines your behavior.

4. **Read 2 Corinthians 5:16-17.** How does this encourage you in understanding who you are in Christ? What lies does the enemy tell us to try and make us believe otherwise? What lies have you heard/believed?
5. How can we pray for each other regarding the need to walk in our true identity in Christ? Spend some time praying for each other, specifically renouncing the lies of the enemy.

Renouncement prayer: "Dear Heavenly Father, I confess that I've been deceived by believing (name lies believed about identity). In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce these lies and any influence the enemy has had over me for believing them. I choose to believe who I am in Christ. Thank you for your forgiveness. Strengthen me by the power of your Holy Spirit so I may walk in the truth of who you say I am. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.
