Game Changer - Ascension Sunday

- 1 What is something you were afraid of as a kid?
- 2 What are some of your fears today? Why is the unknown something we so easily fear? How do our imaginations play into our fear...whether it is health, economy, government, or something else?
- 3 Read Acts 1:1-11. What sticks out to you from the ascension passage?
- 4 Read Ephesians 1:17. When were you in a crisis or situation and you prayed for wisdom and revelation for that circumstance and situation? Why might knowing God be more important than any other wisdom or revelation?
- 5 Read Ephesians 1:18-21. What has God done? Why is the ascension important? Where is Jesus now? Who has all power, or what power is above all others?
- 6 Read Ephesians 1:22-23. Jesus has been given all power for what?
- 7 Read Romans 8:28. When you combine this passage with what you have just studied in Ephesians 1, what would this say to all our, and all your past, current, and future fears?
- 8 Fear has a great deal of power, what fear do you need to place under the power of Jesus who is over all things? What would it look like for you to live into and grow into Ephesians 1:18-19a?
- 9 Pray together! Praise God together for what he has done in Christ...and what he is currently doing as Jesus sits on the throne as King!



Ephesians 1:17-23

I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.
