They swore a curse on themselves if they failed to obey the Law of God as issued by His servant Moses. They solemnly promised to carefully follow all the commands, regulations, and decrees of the Lord our Lord" (NLT).</li> <li>Colossians 3:16a, "Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom " (NASB).</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>The word translated as "dwell" is the Greek New Testament word [ἐνοικείτω, enoiketo] and it mean "to take up" In other words, Paul is exhorting the believer to let the Word of God make a in your heart.</li> <li>The word translated as "richly" is the Greek New Testament word [πλουσίως, plousios] and it mear "to have an abundance, to have an overflow, and too be extravagant."</li> </ul>

It will provide for everything necessary for the work of the Temple of our God 39The people and the Levites must bring these offerings of grain, new wine, and olive oil to the storerooms and place them in the sacred containers near the ministering priests, the gatekeepers, and the singers.
