Hopeful Listening Workshop with Dr. Carlus Gupton

Friday, June 2nd, 6:30-9pm - Saturday June 3rd, 8:30am-2pm FLC

We are embarking on a journey to help us understand our congregational strengths, needs, and hopes as a basis for being more effective and intentional in our mission here at Broadway.

This will be a significant focus for our congregation over the next several months and we need everyone to participate and be engaged in this process. We hope to come through this effort with a more unified, clear, missional direction for Broadway.

Next weekend, Dr. Gupton will be back with us to begin the discussion portion of this growth process.

It is strongly encouraged that those who choose to participate be able to come for both the Friday and Saturday sessions. If you are unable to be here for the whole weekend, please make every effort to attend Friday evening. Attendees will be in groups of 6 for a series of led discussions. The groups will remain the same for the entire process. It is not come-and-go.

Participants will be interviewing one another and be in discussion the whole time. Friday will have us breaking from six into three people to a group interviewing each other. Saturday we will be working together in groups gradually increasing in size through the day to discuss and present on those discussions to the whole group.

There will be a meal served Friday evening beginning at 5:30, and snacks will be made available during breaks. Saturday there will be continental breakfast items available as we begin the day. Lunch will also be provided.

Dr. Gupton shared the core principle of this workshop with us in his first visit: "The lived reality of a congregation is defined by whatever participants think about, talk about, work on, dream about, or plan. While we do not need to dismiss the serious challenges we face, we need to center our attention on our strengths. Focus has to do with imagination, conversation, efforts, and vision. Simply by refocusing attention, giving energy and priority to positive narratives, we can become a different congregation."

Please prayerfully consider participating in this listening workshop.
