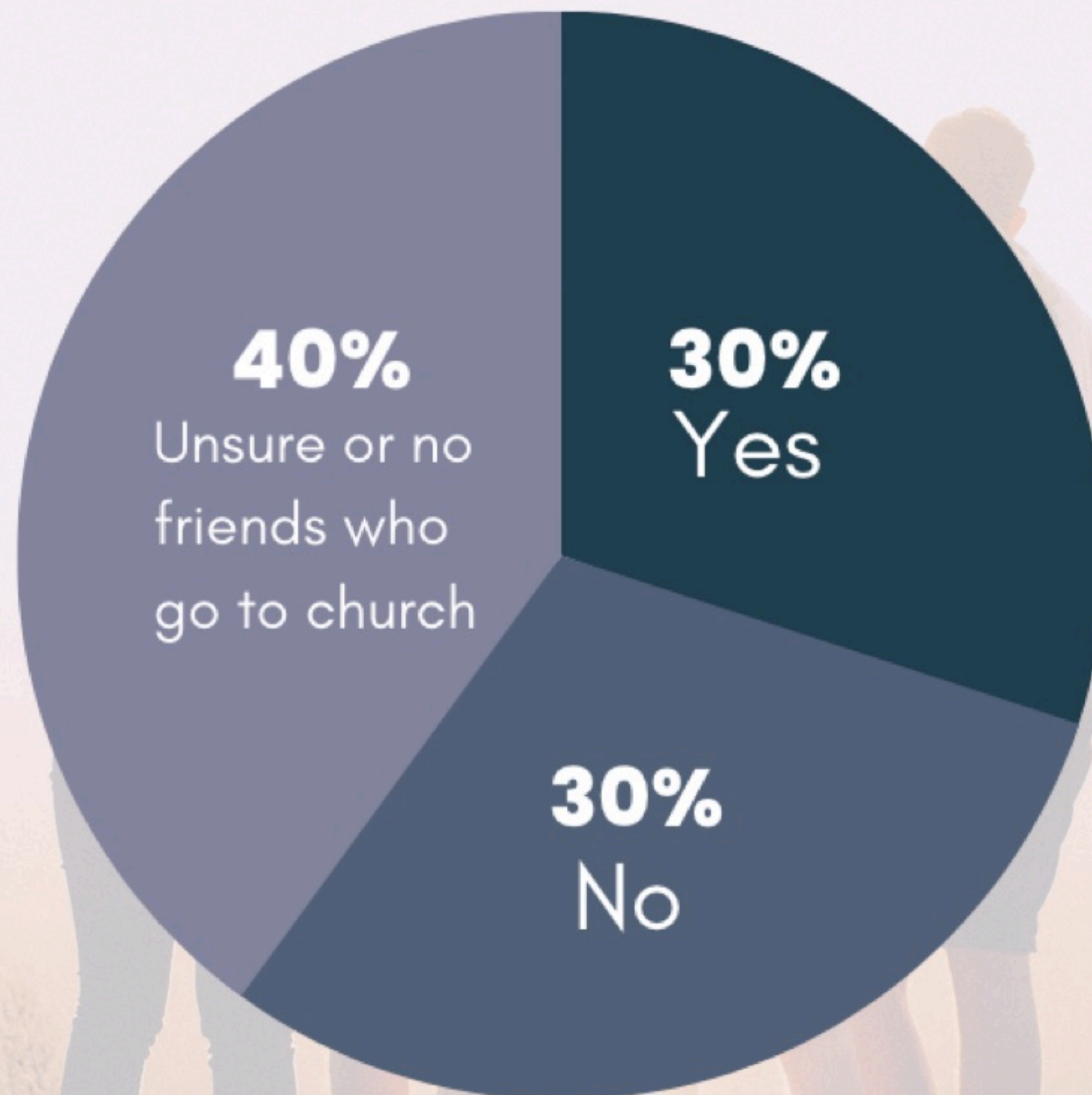

The Gospel mission

- 1. Going – outward facing, sending, responsibility**
- 2. Preaching – sharing, proclaiming, teaching**
- 3. Saving – Forgiveness of sins, transformation, miracles,
grace, no condemnation**
- 4. Enabling – Holy Spirit power, Jesus is with you, protection**

SERMON APPLICATION:

Do – Create a list of friends & family who you could share the Good News about Jesus with.

Pray – Say a prayer for each person on your list.
