What makes us Presbyterian and why is that different than most other churches in San Diego? We will get to know ourselves better as a congregation in South Coast Presbytery of the PCA.

H.O.M.E., Households, & Hospitality (Room 204) Teachers/Facilitators: Various

This Sunday, June 4, Joe Brandi will join us from Unity 4 Orphans and teach us how to get involved in this ministry. Joe was an intern at New Life many years ago when he was attending Reformed Theological Seminary. U4O is a charitable organization established to raise awareness, unite communities, and mobilize people towards creatively and tangibly investing in the lives of abandoned and neglected children. He leads missions trips to orphanages in Mexico. Unity 4 Orphans has roots in the Christian faith and Joe Brandi, the founder, is an ordained minister. While they hold fast to those values, they are not a religious organization but are recognized by the IRS as a Public Charity. This means their service trips are attended by people of all faiths and many of their volunteers and supporters have differing religious views. Per Dylan Loureiro who has gone on one of these missions trips and from what I hear from the people at Resurrection Presbyterian, who go on a regular basis, Joe is great at presenting the Gospel to all in attendance on those trips, whether or not they are Christians.

Next Sunday, June 11, Mark and Dayna Blair, missionaries who have received support from New Life for many years, will share about their experiences as they have been trying for 40 years to share Jesus with their lives and lips; with Muslims in USA, Uganda, Central Asia, and China, with Buddhists in Asia, with Atheists in Kazakhstan and China, with 'religious' but unsaved 'Christians' everywhere, and now Nones in Hawaii. Three things that have kept them going are, 1) Love from Jesus who continues to pour out mercy and grace to them, 2) Vision of the harvest fields over which He is Lord, and 3) Hope in His eternal purpose in which every tongue will confess, "Jesus Christ is Lord!," which is now dimly reflected in the local church.
