
How can I help the library?

- * Tell others about what you've seen in the library and what you've read.









Finding what you want-


- * <u>Stories</u> are shelved in alphabetical order using the first three letters of the author's last name.

FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

How do I sign out a book?

Simply sign your name and phone number on the borrower's card. Leave it in the labelled container on top of the bookshelf.

How long can I keep things?

Normally we ask that you return materials within one month of signing them out.
