Some people prefer to use the stones rather

than the candles. They are available during the Service on Sunday morning or at any time you might be in the building.

The invitation is to hold the stone in your hand and, in doing so, placing your prayer, your energy, your beyond-word-aspirations into the stone. From a Celtic perspective, a spark of the Spirit of the Creator remains at the centre of all matter and all life so that your spirit communes with the Spirit as you pray (or even just as you mark a moment of silence) and the stone "remembers and holds you forever after".
