- 1. What stood out to you from this Sunday's sermon?
- 2. **Review Ephesians 6:12-13**. What stands out to you from these verses and why? How does this impact your understanding of spiritual warfare?
- 3. Review 1 Peter 5:8-9. What stands out to you from these verses and why?
- 4. Some people have a background where there was a lot of teaching about spiritual warfare and others had backgrounds where there was not as much. If you are being transparent, is this material difficult or easy for you with your background? Explain?
- 5. The author of 'Resilient', David Young, teaches that a rich relationship with the Holy Spirit has always been central to standing strong in a hostile world. In what ways do you agree with him and how can we each make that kind of relationship a reality?
- 6. Would you say that it's easy or difficult for you to recognize the "enemy behind the enemy?" How can you become more aware of the spiritual bondage others experience because they've believed Satan's lies? How will this affect your response to them (especially to those who may offend or persecute you)?
- 7. Spend some time in prayer as a group on a micro and macro level:
- a. Micro-spiritual warfare prayers for those who are personally close to us who are being deceived by the enemy.
- b. Macro-Pray for our town, state, country–for those who are being deceived. That they would be drawn to Christ (Conviction, Repentance, and Freedom.)
