VIRTUS is the brand name that identifies best practice programs designed to help prevent wrong-doing and promote "right doing" within religious organizations. The VIRTUS program empowers organizations and people to better control risk and improve the lives of all those who interact with the Church. When caring adults have a "healthy suspicion" about something in their surroundings, they can identify the risks to children early enough to prevent child sexual abuse from occurring. All adults are protectors of children. As adults, it is our role in the faith community to keep our eyes and ears open and to report any suspicious activity to appropriate authorities and church officials.

VIRTUS Training is required for all those volunteering with children. If you plan to volunteer in our school, childcare center, or youth formation programs you must be VIRTUS trained.
